



E²NHANCE Application: a 5 Step guide

This document provides you a step by step guide on how to apply for an E²NHANCE mobility grant.

In case you have any question or you need additional help, you are encouraged to contact your local representative. To know the contact person, please look under the Consortium section to know the person you may approach.

Step 1: Determine your Target Group.

Please go to the [Mobility > Target Groups](#) section on the web page to know the classification that applies to you.

Step 2: Are you a potential applicant?

You should be eligible in order to apply. You'll find the specific conditions at the [Scholarships > Eligibility criteria](#) section.

Step 3: What are your interests?

Once you know you are eligible, according to your level of study you should:

- If you belong to a Lot 21 country: Browse the table under [Fields of Study > Fields of Study by Discipline/University](#). There you'll find the concrete E²NHANCE offer made by EU universities classified according to the level of study and Field of Study. Take note that you can choose (when filling the application form) up to three destinations. Also bear in mind that for some levels of study different durations are available. You should choose the one that better fits your needs.
- If you belong to an EU country: As the offered study levels are at Doctorate, Post-doctorate and Academic Staff, the best thing to do is to approach the corresponding institution of your interest (either via some contact you may have or the local E²NHANCE coordinator). Later on when filling the application form you'd need to choose the field of study from a standard classification.

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Step 4: Do you have ready the required documents?

According to your level of study, before proceeding to fill in the application form you should be aware of the documentation you'll need to supply. Please take a look at [Application > Required Documents](#). An electronic version of such documents will be required.

Step 5: Fill in the application form

At this point, you are ready to submit your application. The on-line application form can be found at [Application > Application form](#). The requested data is filled in four steps:

- Generic Data: about you and the required mobility (Target group, Level of Study, Duration, etc)
- Personal Data: basic data about you
- Host Institution and Programme requests: Here you can specify up to three hosts destinations and their corresponding programmes you're applying for.
- Documents Upload: You'll be asked to supply electronic versions of the required documents.
